Thank you for supporting the Compact's efforts to enhance our Cumberland River and its many tributaries through your donation of \$200.00 in February, 2006.

After successfully educating and organizing our 7th watershed group in the Old Hickory Watershed, we now begin facilitating watershed meetings in the Collins River Watershed. We also continue to educate local officials through our new Local Officials Community Water Curriculum. Educating our local officials can lead to better land management decisions – ultimately improving the health of our rivers. Among many other efforts, the Water Quality Advisory Committee is collaborating with the US Army Corps of Engineers on designing a Cumberland and Tennessee River's study - the first of its kind - that will encompass a review of recreation, reservoir operations, navigation, environmental impacts, and several other areas. Our Building Outside the Box program is now working on-the-ground in three watersheds implementing best management practices and unique restoration techniques. All of these programs are making a difference in our mighty Cumberland River and her tributaries.
